A "newcomer" meeting is one which is considered good for people in early recovery. "Big Book" or "literature" meetings are meetings which use A.A. literature to provide themes for the meeting. "Step" meetings are ones which use the A.A. 12 step programme of recovery as a theme for the meetings.
